

AN ACT to authorise a supplementary appropriation to the . service of the year ending the 31st December 1981.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1981 Supplementary Appropriation (No 3) Act 1982.

Authorisation of issue of \$632,000 from the Consolidate d Fund. 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum not exceeding six hundred and thirty-two thousand dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1981.

Appropriation. 3. The sum specified in section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the head specified, and in the amount specified, in the Schedule.
