The 1982 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1982

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1982 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1982.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of one million seven hundred and ninety-seven thousand and six hundred and ninety-five dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1982.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule.

Appropriation.

4. In the Second Schedule to the 1982 Appropriation Act 1982 in column 1 for "\$2,500,000" (local costs of development projects) substitute "\$4,000,000."
