

IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) ACT 1986

NO. 8 OF 1986

Passed by the National Parliament this second day of July 1986.

AN ACT to amend the Immigration Act 1978; and for connected purposes.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

This Act may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Act Citation and com-1986 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister mencement. shall appoint by notice published in the Gazette. Amendment of Section 7(1)(a) of the Immigration Act 1978 (hereinafter called section 7(1)(a) the "principal Act") is amended by substituting the word of Act No. 27 "children" for the word "family". of 1978. Notwithstanding section 2 of this Act, any person who -Transitional 3. provision (a) before the coming into operation of this Act, was entiregarding Immigration tled to enter, reside or work in Solomon Islands and work pursuant to section 7(1)(a) of the principal Act; and permits. (b) at the coming into operation of this Act, has entered and is residing in Solomon Islands, is entitled to continue residing and working in Solomon Islands, without having to obtain either a permit under section 8 of the principal Act or a work permit under section 68 of the Labour Act, for a period of three months commencing on the date that this Act comes into operation. (2) Any person to whom subsection (1) applies may apply for a permit under section 8 of the principal Act and under section 68 of the Labour Act to be issued to him within the period of three months mentioned in that subsection. (3) Where an application is made under subsection (2), the Principal Immigration Officer or the Commissioner of Labour, as the case may be, shall not unreasonably refuse or unreasonably delay the granting of the permit.
