

AN ACT to amend the Census Act, Cap. 29.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

This Act may be cited as the Census (Amendment) Act Short title. 1987. The Census Act (hereinafter referred to as the "principal" Addition of section 7A Act") is amended by adding immediately below section 7 the ito Cap.29. following:-"Delivery of 7A. (1) As soon as reasonably practicable after making such reports of the census and abstracts of returns to Government the returns under section 7, the Commissioner shall deliver such abstracts and any other documents com-Statistician. prised in the returns to the Government Statistician No. 6 of 1970. appointed under the Statistics Act 1970. (2) Sections 6, 7 and 13 of the Statistics Act 1970 shall apply in relation to any abstract, document or information comprising or contained in any returns delivered to the Government Statistician pursuant to subsection (1).". Section 8 of the principal Act is amended:-Amendment of section 8. (a) in subsection (1), by substituting for the expression "twenty dollars" the expression "six hundred dollars"; (b) in subsection (2), by substituting for the expression "one hundred dollars" the expression "one thousand two hundred dollars".
