

AN ACT to amend the Leadership Code (Further Provisions) Act 1979.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

This Act may be cited as the Leadership Code (Further Provi Short title. sions) (Amendment) Act 1987. 2. Section 18 of the Leadership Code (Further Provisions) Act Amendment of section 18 1979 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) is hereby amended of Act No.7 of 1979. as follows by inserting in subsection (2) immediately after the words "The Commission shall investigate" the words "or may lawfully delegate or authorise any person it deems fit to investigate"; and (b) by inserting therein immediately after subsection (4) the following new subsection -(5) On completion of an investigation by a person duly authorised under subsection (2), he shall submit his findings to the Commission, who shall thereupon make such determination as provided for in section 21.". The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting therein imme-Insertion of new section diately after section 23 the following new section -23A. "Practice, 23A. It is hereby declared that the powers, practice and procedure relating to an investigation before the powers and procedure Commission in pursuance of this Part shall, mutatis mutandis, be the powers, practice and procedure to apply mutatis to investigations before a person duly authorised under subsection (2) of section 18 to investigate mutandis. a complaint.".
