

AN ACT to amend the Penal Code.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

This Act may be cited as the Penal Code (Amendment) Act Short title. 1987. The Penal Code is hereby amended by inserting therein imme-2. Insertion diately after section 166 the following new section of new section Possession 166A. (1) Where any person has in his pos-166A in of obscene session, any obscene video tape or photograph Cap.5. (whether an original, reproduction or copy) in video tape circumstances which raise a reasonable or photopresumption that such obscene video tape or graph. photograph was imported into Solomon Islands, shall in the absence of reasonable excuse, be treated as being in possession of such video tape or photograph, as the case may be, for the purposes mentioned in section 166 and in contravention of the provisions of section Customs and Excise Act. (2) Any other person who is found in the company of that person in those circumstances shall, in the absence of reasonable excuse, be treated as also being in possession of such obscene video tape or photograph, as the case may be, for the same purposes mentioned in section 166, and in con-Cap. 58. travention of the Customs and Excise Act.".
