

## THE 1987 SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT (NO. 2) 1988

(NO. 5 OF 1988)

AN ACT to appropriate six million three hundred and forty five thousand one hundred dollars to the service of the year ending 31st December 1987.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1987 Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2) Act 1988.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$6,345,100 to the service of 1987.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of six million three hundred and forty five thousand and one hundred dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st, December 1987.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule to this Act.
