AN ACT to amend the Immigration Act 1978.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title and commencement. 1. This Act may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Act 1989, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may appoint by notice in the Gazette.

Amendment of sec. 9 of Act No. 27 of 1978.

2. Subsection 2 of section 9 of the Immigration Act is hereby amended by deleting the word "fourteen" that appears in the proviso to that subsection and substituting therefor the word "thirty".
