

AN ACT to Amend the Civil Aviation Act 1986.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title and commencement. 1. This Act may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Amendment) Act 1990 and shall come into force on such date as the Minister may appoint by notice published in the Gazette.

Insertion of new section 5A in in Act No.7 of

- 2. The Civil Aviation Act is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 5, the following new section -
- "Ground-handling 5A. (1) The Minister may by Order designate agents.

 any person or persons to be a ground-handling agent or agents for all scheduled international flight services.
 - (2) In this section, "ground-handling" means -
 - (a) marshalling aircraft on arrival;
 - (b) loading and unloading of luggage and cargo;
 - (c) providing passenger and luggage check-in service;
 - (d) cleaning aircraft internally on arrival; and
 - (e) notifying Customs, Immigration, Quarantine and Health Authorities of aircraft movements.".
