

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TWENTY-SIX MILLION SEVENTY FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND FORTY DOLLARS FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING THE 31ST DECEMBER 1991.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the 1991 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1991.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$26,074,640 the Service of 1991.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of twenty six million, seventy four thousand six hundred and forty dollars to be applied to the Service of the year ending 31st December 1991.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the First Schedule.
