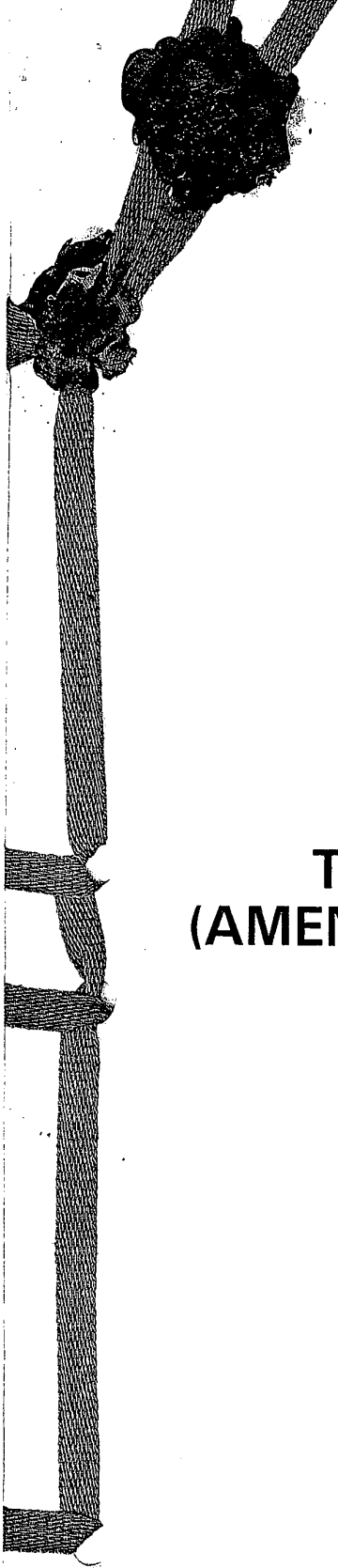

AN ACT To Amend the Sales Tax Act 1990.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Sales Tax (Amendment) Act 1995.

2. Subsection (1) of section 21 of the Sales Tax Act is hereby amended by deleting the words "ten per cent of the tax collectable per day" and substituting therefor the words "twenty per cent per annum of the tax collectable".
