Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1996 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1996.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of sixty two million five hundred and ninety four thousand, seven hundred and forty nine dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1996.
