AN ACT TO AMEND THE POLICE Act (Cap. 110);

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Act 2005.

Amendment of section 4 of Cap 110.

2. Section 4 of the Police Act is hereby amended by deleting the words “a Deputy Commissioner of Police” and substituting therefor the words “two or more Deputy Commissioners of Police”.

THE POLICE (AMENDMENT) BILL 2005

Objects and Reasons

The current Police Act provides for the position of a Deputy Commissioner. The ongoing support for the rebuilding of the Royal Solomon Islands Police has created the need for additional Deputy Police Commissioners.

This Bill therefore seeks to amend the current Police Act to provide for two or more Deputy Police Commissioners to be appointed.
